Hey everyone, welcome to the Mary Sue Test workshop. If you wish to simply take the test and see how any of your characters do you can go here: http://springhole.net/writing/marysue.htm

It is very extensive with detail about almost all things character development and sometimes I find that it offers questions to parts of your characters biography that you may not have considered.

There are the following parts:

Part 1 All Characters, asking nearly every question imaginable about nearly every aspect of your character.

Part 2 Original Fiction Characters, 3 questions about Uberness, skills and romance.

Part 3 Fan Characters & Newcommers, so characters that have connections with canon characters.

Part 4 RPG Characters, asking for RPG type situations.

Part 5 De-suifiers, so general characteristics that make the character's weaknesses a stronger part of the character.

A Mary Sue for those who don't know is a character given or expected to be given unwarranted preferential treatment and unearned respect, thereby compromising the integrity and believability of the story and or characters.
