Hello all, and welcome to a special discussion around Age Ratings and your sim. Or as Ben and I have been calling it "Age Ratings: Be TV Kirk, Not Internet Kirk."

Today's panel is going to focus on age ratings, the different levels, and how to work with those ratings to still be an inclusive and welcoming community on the internet. For context, we'll be using the RPG Rating system, which you can see below. You can find it at rpgrating.com/create. Other sims might use other systems, but for a unified single appearance, we'll be using this one.

And you can work with it. For those more inclined to the Discovery style of expression, you may show a bit more (leaning into a 3/18+ setting) and fade before you get to the actual bits. Alternatively, you might prefer a scene of your characters on a bed, Some light kissing, and a cut to one of the characters putting their boots back on.

But you need to make sure whatever you are writing is marked clearly. If you are a CO looking to allow this style of content, maybe consider implementing a rating system for the titles to warn people.

Some sims are heavily into character building and the development of a relationship (including the physical attraction component) can play a bit role in that.

My site is 18+ overall because I don't want to deal with people's parents or the legalities of dealing with people who can't technically agree to terms of use or whatever, and I allow each RP on it to set their own RPG ratings in terms of language, violence, and sexuality. Plots with NSFW content are kept in forums that only members who specifically request access to them can see, so no one accidentally sees or reads about something smutty unless they want to. This system seems to work well for us.

I got an nsfw channel on my discord and if you've signed up for nsfw content on the forum, our bot lets you in, and boy do people post some freaky stuff in there. 😛

But I do want to start bringing this to a conclusion.

As part of the big finish, I want to remind people that a big part of simming is working with other people, discussing what you want to happen and how you want those to play out. Make sure you as both a player and GM have open and candid discussions with your crew. While you lead the game, a quick way to lead your players away is by huge changes people might not want. The Vesta for example has internal "command" discussions on smaller matters, but bigger matters and changes will always be sent out to the crew. If anyone wants to leave, there is never any hard feelings around people wanting to sim their way.

Keeping these options open to players, and being honest about these options is the best way to run a game with a crew of people that share a degree of high mutual respect. At the end of the day that respect will be what makes people happy and keeps sims going for long times.

In short, don't be afraid to fade to black when you're done heavy petting and they're laid out on their back.
